Severe Weather Policy

Prior to Game Time

Game status updates will be available on our rainout line (493-7766) or our website: kestonelittleleague.com after approximately 3:00 pm on weekdays and 8:00 am on weekends when there is inclement weather or wet fields. If there is no daily update assume your game will be played as scheduled. Game-time cancellations may be made if there are late changes in the weather. We understand it is an inconvenience to travel to the park only to have your game cancelled, but our goal is to play whenever weather conditions allow.

Weather Watches: If we are in a watch area our games will be played as scheduled. In this situation you as parent or guardian have the right to decide on whether or not to go to the park.

At the Park

In the event lightning is seen or thunder is heard, we will sound one blast of an air horn from the concession stand. At this point play is to be suspended immediately on all fields (no finishing of a batter or inning) and people should go to their cars and wait.

Play will be suspended until 20 minutes has passed without any lightning or thunder. Once the storm has cleared, we will signal with two blasts of the air horn from the concession stand to resume play.

Keystone Little League recognizes that we all want the games to be played, and we occasionally observe that thunder may be heard in the distance with no rain at the fields and the sun still shining. The National Weather Service reports that lightning can strike 10 miles from a thunderstorm and it is imperative that we not take chances in this area. The safety of our players, parents, coaches, and spectators is our top priority and adherence to this policy is a component of this priority.

If the severe weather siren sounds at the complex, play is to be suspended immediately and it will not resume. Everyone should head for safety. Managers and Coaches, make sure every player on your team is accounted for and has someone to go with for safety.
